

PBIS(Wildcat Pride) Reinforcement System

- Every staff member is encouraged to recognize students at any time and in any location for following expectations. Staff members do this by filling out a “Wildcat Pride Slip.” The slip is a carbon copy form, listing the four expectations. The student gets the white portion to keep and take home. The staff member puts the yellow copy in a box in the office to be drawn.
- At the end of every week, students who have a slip in the box have a chance in a drawing. The drawing is performed during announcements and we recognize the two students who were drawn at random. We tell what they did and also call them to the office for a prize. They also get something for the teacher and must go to the teacher and thank them for catching them following expectations.
- Each Semester we will have a drawing of all the students that have received a Wildcat Pride slip during the semester. This drawing will be for an MP3 player or something similar.
- Each Semester we will also have an entertainment/reward for all students that have homework done and no discipline problems independent of receiving a Wildcat Pride Slip. Each teacher will decide which students are eligible for the reward according to their behavior and homework.
